My name is James McDonald, and I was shocked to learn about the death of my longtime friend. I discovered his dynamic evangelism when he preached a revival at our church in Zanesville, Ohio. When I was the Ohio District Council Young Peoples Union chairman in 1978, Robert organized a 5K run during our state convention which health-conscious event was a creative and unprecedented Council activity. We were both nominated to be Chairman of the ODCYPU in 1979, and he won (and I was the incumbent). He led the ODCYPU for many years and I served as his publicist. I knew he had aspirations to pastor and was happy for him when I learned he was moving to Longview, Texas to succeed Noel Jones who was headed to Los Angeles to understudy with Robert McMurray. The teaching that resonates with me to this day was his teaching on what is now known as Emotional Intelligence. I learned that I was in control of my emotions and that anger was not caused by others but was the result of my own thoughts. He showed us that love was God's foremost gift and "Oh My" did He share it in abundance. His beloved wife, Mary is one of the sweetest people I have ever met. Today I embrace her. My tears are flowing, and my memoirs are comforting me. My prayers are with Bethel Temple.
