



Mildred Umblas Romualdo

December 18, 1962 - October 30, 2024

Mildred U. Romualdo, 61, sadly passed away on October 30, 2024. Mildred was born on December 18, 1962, in Manila, Philippines to Leovigildo and Irinea Romualdo. She was the third child out of their four children. Mildred went to Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic School and graduated from high school at Bishop Dunne in 1981. Shortly after high school, Mildred worked for the Dallas County Jail, mainly in the Bails and Bonds department, serving as a supervisor for the last part of her work years. During the 40 years at Dallas County Jail, Mildred was known to be a passionate, dedicated, hardworking, and feisty individual, working even after being diagnosed with breast cancer, even during her radiation and chemo. She refused to let cancer dictate her life. Just this year, in 2024, she decided to “hang up” her Sheriff’s uniform to finally retire with hopes to enjoy her years with her family and to just relax and focus on her health. Typical, Mildred, not wanting to be the center of attention on her retirement day, she reported to work, clocked-in, stayed an hour, told 4 coworkers, and left. She didn’t want a party, fanfares, confetti, or a parade. All she wanted was just a simple “good-bye”. Mildred had always been a fighter and refused to take “no” for an answer. She fought and was not willing to give up without a fight, but some things she was not able to win, and it was this battle with cancer. Just like at work, she did not see the need to be the center of attention so only shared her condition and diagnosis with her family and a handful of friends. Despite spending much of her time in treatment, she never lost her smile and humor. Throughout her journey, she spread joy, made

everyone laugh, and showed remarkable strength, regardless of what the circumstances were. Mildred loved her children and was always there for them. She was always their number one supporter, was always there to offer her love, support, and encouragement, even during her roughest days. To her children, she was loving but fair. She made sure to instill her values on them as well as the importance of honesty, love, and perseverance. Mildred is survived by her 2 sons, Darius and Mark; her grandsons, Elijah and Jack; her loving companion for 30 years Stephen Crummel; her father Leo; her siblings, Glenn (Svet) Romualdo and their 2 sons, Edna (Dan) Regala and their 4 children, Alvin (Dori) Romualdo and their 1 daughter. Mildred is preceded in death by her 2 older sons, Pierre and Stephen, and her mother, Irinea. Mildred left an imprint on our lives and the lives she touched. Her love will be dearly missed. The flower that bloomed on earth is now a flower in Heaven.
