In the Year of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, on the third day of February Two Thousand & Twenty, The voice of the Lord spoke, the flood gates opened and the peace of eternal rest rained down and carried Semmie Isaiah Williams Sr. to his eternal rest.

On the 6th day of February in the year Nineteen Hundred & Forty Eight in Brady, Texas, a strapping boy was birthed to Alfred Williams, and his wife Pearline, they called his name Semmie.

Semmie moved from Brady with his family to Levelland, Texas, where he attended Levelland High School, and later joined the Job Corps. During his time as a student in the Job Corp, Semmie was drafted into the United States Air Force where he with no fear was prepared to fight in the Vietnam War. Even then grace found him as the day the plane he was on was about to touch down, the announcement that the war was over was made. Once his tenure in the Air Force was complete, Semmie returned to Levelland where he

met the love of his youth Emily Jean McBride and took her to be his wife. In 1973 Semmie packed up his wife, and first borne son and relocated to Dallas, Texas. Shortly after arriving in the City, Semmie came across the path of Brother Kermit Patterson and Stewart Williams, who made it their business to witness the life changing power of Jesus Christ to him and left him with the desire to give his life to the Lord. That same year Semmie joined himself to Full Gospel Holy Temple and yielded himself to God, under the Leadership of the Late Apostle Lobias Murray. His Servitude at Full Gospel extended to the brotherhood choir, the Jail Ministry, Prayer Service, the Elite Force, where he served until his health would not allow. Semmie was also a devoted Butcher, and ran Butchers Blocks from Minyard's to Albertsons, from Albertsons to Krogers with precision and integrity, until the day he retired.

Preceding him in death, is the wife of his youth Emily Jean Williams, Infant Son Emmitt Eugene Williams, grandson Issac Williams, his seven siblings and his parents.

Left to mourn his absence is his wife Dianne Boyd Williams whom he married after Emily's eternal departure, and her three wonderful children whom he loved as his own.

Those left to carry on his servitude are his children Semmie Williams Jr., Malcolm Williams and his beautiful wife Tawanta, Sheresa Williams, Cathy Lawson Baily (God Daughter) and Anna Katrina Kelly (daughter in love,) 9 grandsons, 4 granddaughters, and a host of Royal nieces and nephews. Through them his legacy remains and shall live on.
